

The 3rd National Meeting in Belgium concerning Clionet, Clionres.net, Tuning, ... took place in Namur, on the occasion of the 'Congrès Historique et Archéologique' that is organized every four years. After the National Meeting in Antwerp (2002) and Brussels (2005), it was organized this time on the 30th of August 2008 in the French speaking part of Belgium. A bit more than 350 people were registered in advance, but more or less 400 historians participated in practice. This 'Congrès' is attended by almost all historians of the French speaking universities in Belgium and gives young researchers an opportunity to present the progress of their work.
