

Cliohnet 2 National meeting and dissemination activities organized in Czech Republic by Charles University in Prague

2007 – June - 13

National dissemination meeting of Cliohnet was held on the occasion of International methodological workshop in Prague. The title „Perception of space – „Ours“ and „Theirs“ Contributions and possibilities of komparative Metod in social studies: Formation of regions, cultural borders and identities. (Vnímání prostoru: „Naše“ a „Jejich“. Přínos a možnosti komparativní metody pro studium sociálních procesů: Utváření regionů, kulturních hranic a identit.) The workshop was organised together with the Institute of Philosophy of the Academy of Science and Institute of Political Science of the Faculty of Social Sciences. The workshop was presenting the results of the Prague Cliohres team and displaying the results of Cliohnet. It was internationally attended by representatives of partner universities in Clioh projects: dr. Elena Mannová (Bratislava, cliohnet and Cliohres member) doc. Leos Miller (Uppsala – Cliohnet member), Doc. Jaroslav Miller and Mgr. Petr Černíkovský (Olomouc Cliohnet member). Dr. Linas Eriksonas from Vilnius presented socio-structural analysis of Cliohnet as a social practices in writing history, which was received with great interest. He has analyse network building and a representations of the network through available sources and on the basis of Cliohnet publications in diachronic perspective and in comparison with Cliohres network.
